

# **TRILOGY AT GLEN IVY AMPHITHEATER RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **22 TRILOGY GLEN IVY AMPHITHEATER**

The Trilogy Amphitheater is an open-air venue, available for use year round, weather permitting. The amphitheater features grass seating with a large concrete stage area perfect for concerts, neighborhood gatherings and private parties.

- 22.1 A reservation application can be obtained at the Trilogy Pacific Crest Lodge. All dates must be reserved in advance.
- 22.2 If food and drink will be included in the event, a security deposit must accompany the reservation application. This deposit is required to ensure proper clean up after an event and to cover the costs of any necessary repairs, damages or loss to the association.
- 22.3 Deposits will be refunded in full if proper clean up is completed and no damage occurs.
- 22.4 Residents may bring lawn chairs or blankets for seating on the grass.
- 22.5 The Amphitheater may be reserved by TGMA or TGIS.
- 22.6 Food and Beverages may be brought into the amphitheater area. Residents who use the amphitheater area are required to clean the surrounding area completely of trash and opened containers. Failure to do so will result in an additional cleaning fee being assessed the resident. No glass containers are permitted in the Amphitheater area.
- 22.7 Amphitheater hours are from 10:00 a.m. till 11:00 p.m.
- 22.8 Bands with amplification systems must end at 11:00 p.m. to ensure the tranquility of Trilogy's residents and surrounding areas. Music must be kept at an acceptable level at all times, so as not to disturb the neighboring residents.
- 22.9 Decorations must be superficial, non-permanent, and non-marring. Residents may not use anything permanent such as glue, paint, nails, duct tape or screws to attach or enhance decorations on any real or personal property belonging to the association.
